### Clarification of News Report

We reply to your request for clarification on a news article entitled "L&R sets P400M for retail gaming blitz" published in the August 3, 2015 issue of the BusinessWorld. The article reported in part that:

"LEISURE and Resorts World Corp. (LRWC) is spending as much as P400 million this year in a bid to boost its presence in the retail gaming sector.

LRWC Chairman and President Reynaldo P. Bantug told reporters last week the capital spending will cover the opening of 10 to 15 neighborhood bingo boutiques and Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corp. (Pagcor) E-Games stations for the year, as well as the expansion of Midas Hotel.

We confirm the above-quoted news article focusing on Mr. Bantug's statement on the opening of bingo boutiques within a range of 10-15 outlets. We clarify that the estimate of 10-15 outlets is based on past year's performance and is still subject to PAGCOR approval. We likewise clarify that the estimate of Php400 Million includes the refurbishing of existing outlets.
